

CHAPTER 25 | Yin and Yang

The Yin and Yang symbol is the Eastern expression of the universe and symbolizes the balance between male and female nature in everything that surrounds us. Related to this is the Flower of Life, also called Genesis Pattern. In this flower of life the five Platonic forms can be found, namely the tetrahedron (4 planes), the cube (6 planes), the octahedron (8 planes), the dodecahedron (12 planes) and finally the icosahedron (20 planes). The Platonic solids have very remarkable properties. They all fit in a sphere. The outer points of the forms all lie on the surface of a circle. Also all forms fit perfectly together. All forms have a counterpart. An opposite form that can be created from the other. The cube for example has the octahedron as counterpart. If the centres of the planes of a cube are connected to each other by means of lines, an octahedron is created. The same process can be reversed to create a cube from an octahedron. The tetrahedron knows itself as a counterpart. The dodecahedron and the icosahedron are also counterparts of each other. Every line, plane and angle in a Platonic body are identical to every other line, plane or angle from the same shape. The Platonic bodies are extremely symmetrical. According to Plato - in his book 'Timaeus' - these five figures are the basic building blocks of the atoms. The building blocks of matter: fire, air, water, earth and the fifth element celestial matter, also called ether. The universe is said to have been formed according to these fixed geometric proportions. This geometric ratio is also referred to as 'The Golden Ratio'. The Golden Ratio is a division of a line segment or surface into two unequal parts. The smallest part relates to the largest part as the largest part to the whole. The Golden Ratio is the unique relationship that exists in the universe between the whole and the parts. It creates unity in the proportions, so that within the enormous amount of forms, unity and harmony exists in the universe. The Golden Ratio can be found for example in the pyramids of Egypt, in classical buildings like the Notre Dame or the Parthenon, but also in the crop circles in England. Only with a compass and the shop hook, the symbols of freemasonry, this 'sacred geometry' of forms can be constructed. The books of the American writer Dan Brown are amongst others based on this knowledge. This sacred geometry can not only be found in matter, but also on an energetic level. Although the presence of ether as the unifying basis of all things visible and invisible here on earth has been banned by the Church, it does exist. The ancient Greeks already knew this, but recent physical research has shown that ether exists. The physicists David Wilcock and Daniel Winter have shown how not only matter, but also the atom in particular is composed of vibratory structures of Platonic solids. The electromagnetic waves that create this are spiral waves known as Golden Spirals. We perceive these electromagnetic waves as light. If this light can travel freely through space then we experience it as energy, but if it is bound in the form of standing spiral waves in a limited space, then we experience it as matter. Matter is energy with a lower vibration or frequency. So matter is composed of vibrating structures of the five above mentioned platonic solids. So the whole universe is in fact a big vibrating whole, in which everything is



connected to each other. It is like a piece of music. The Golden Spirals are carriers of information. The vibrations from the ether are the source of the geometric forms. This implies that they also carry information within them, information about how they manifest themselves. Sacred Geometry is also called the 'Language of Light'. Our ancestors were very familiar with this. They built their buildings (pyramids) and ritual places (Stone Henge) with this knowledge, because they knew that this was the bridge between the visible and the invisible. It is from this knowledge that it is said that thoughts create form (Quantum Physics). The book 'The Secret' by Rhonda Byrne teaches people how to apply this knowledge in your life. Man thinks he operates alone, but is himself part of this vibrating ether field. The fundamental truth is that everything is connected with each other and therefore (on a level not perceptible by the senses) there is unity in the universe. If you want to be able to activate this then a process inwardly, to the feeling and the intuition, is necessary. Then you are able to tune in to the universal intelligence.
